ACADEMICS

- The date sheet and syllabus for Unit Test cycle 3 was given to the students of classes V-VIII. The tests are going to begin from November 13.
- The school has applied for the prestigious **International School Award** by the British Council. The preparation for the Curriculum Activities has started. - The students started preparing for the Annual Day which to be held on 3rd November 2018. Props and dresses were prepared.

WORKSHOPS

- **IDA Connect and British Council** organised a workshop on October 5 at Pragati Maidan to explore ‘**6 basic core skills**’ identified in the CBSE curriculum and proposed by UNESCO as a part of the **sustainable development goals**. The workshop was conducted by Jemima Hughes and was attended by Ms Anju Tiwari. It was 1 hour workshop in which core skills and their classroom context was elaborately discussed.



- Ms Benu Sidhu attended a workshop organized by British Council on 6th of October at Pragati Maidan. The theme of the workshop was “**Leadership Core Skills**”. It was an informative workshop which guided the educators about developing core leadership skills and helping their students and colleagues to do the same.
- The teachers of Pre-Primary classes attended a workshop conducted by **Grape Seed** at their campus in Sector-62, Noida. The main focus of this workshop was language acquisition and critical listening program for children. The programme involved participation of children in a teacher-led classroom where English is learned with materials and activities. The focus was on acquiring English language naturally without focusing much on grammar.



- As the school has applied for The British Council International School Award (ISA), a workshop was organised by The British Council on 12 October to provide necessary information and road map to achieve the award for the participating schools. School Coordinators were apprised about the criteria to be met for achieving the award. Information and guidance for designing the Curriculum Activities and online support was also provided.
