ACADEMICS

- The Highlight of the month were the Half Yearly Exams. Detailed Revision and Assignment sheets were given to the students for practice. Doubts were cleared and concepts explained in the days leading up to the exams.
- The Half Yearly exams were conducted for students of Classes V-VIII to assess their learning and understanding the concepts. The exams were held from 17th September 2018 to 28th September 2018. Special one hour revision class were organised for the students of classes V-VIII after the exam to clarify their doubts and help them for the next exam.
- **Unit Test Cycle II** continued for the students of Classes I-IV and ended on 25th September 2018.
- 1st September 2018 (Saturday) was a regular working day for the students of Classes Pre-Nursery to VIII in lieu of 9th August (Holiday on account of Kanwar Yatra).
- A **Parent-Teacher Meeting** was organised on 15th September to discuss the progress of their wards with the parents. More than 95% parents attended the meeting. A feedback form was given to the parents which they later deposited in the feedback box kept at the reception of the circular building. Based on the feedback form, the Principal took separate class wise meeting with the teachers. The issues and concerns raised by the parents were discussed.
