### **Rules and regulations:**

3. Each participant will get ANY ONE novel from the given list (Treasure Island, The Adventures of Huckleberry Finn, Around the World in Eighty Days, Little Women) for making the book jacket.
4. The participant will carry three A4 size white or coloured sheets and drawing materials for making the book jacket.
5. The book jackets must be 8.5” x 11” in size.
6. The design should be for the outside front cover only and should include the title of the book and name of the author.
7. The pictorial representation of the theme of the novel should be made in the background of the cover page. The back page should have the Author’s Biography.



8. The Inside cover flap should have a write up of 2-3 sentences describing the main setting of the story and include the main plot of the story with special emphasis on the exposition, rising action, climax, falling action and resolution.

9. Judgment Criteria:

- Cover design and layout (Illustration: Colour theme/Imagery, Author's name and title)
- Back cover and Spine (Author's bio)
- Content
- Overall presentation

**Time allowed:** 2minutes 30 seconds

**Topic:** Man is now technologically a giant but morally a pigmy

#### **Rules and regulations:**

1. Students of Classes IX, X, XI and XII are eligible for the competition.
2. Students must paste the school code and their names on their dresses or at a place where it is clearly visible to the judges.
3. The debating team should consist of 3 students, one speaking for, one against the motion and one interjector. Incomplete teams (without for, against and interjector) cannot participate.
4. Time allowed to each speaker will be 2.5 minutes. Overshooting the time limit and reading from a script may be disadvantageous for the participant.
5. Rebuttal will be marked separately and added to the final score of the teams.



6. Individual entry is not allowed. Only a debating team of two participants will qualify for the competition.

7. Judgment criteria:

- Content
- Clarity of thought and expression
- Fluency
- Rebuttal (Injector)
